PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of October 31st 2021, a total of **5,321,880** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,688,884** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,632,996**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **41.8%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **6.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with **17.9%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **15.8%** Kiambu **9.5%**, Uasin Gishu with **8.4%**, Nyandarua **8.1%**, Kisumu **7.4%**, Muranga **7.3%** and Mombasa **7.2%**, while, Mandera, Wajir, Garissa, and Marsabit are the least counties with less than **1%** of the population fully vaccinated.

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On the Covid-19 situation today **29** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,684** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.8%**. From the cases **22** are Kenyans except **7** that are foreigners. **16** are males and **13** females. The youngest is a **five-year-old child** while the oldest is **83** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **253,339** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,708,500**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **13**, Garissa **6**, Siaya **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Homa Bay **1**, Kisii **1**, Laikipia **1**, Makueni **1**, Trans Nzoia **1** and Baringo **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(6)**, 30-39 **(8)**, 40-49 **(1)**, 50-59 **(4)**, 60 years and above **(9)**.

Today **92** patients have recovered from the disease with **53** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **39** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **246,921** of whom **199,458** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,463** are from various health facilities countrywide.

No deaths have been reported in the last 24 hours. Therefore, cumulative deaths still stand to **5,281**.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(141)**, 30-39 years **(381)**, 40-49 years **(612)**, 50-59 years **(990)** 60 years and above **(3,061)**.

A total of **442** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,188** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **26** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **12** of whom are on ventilatory support and **14** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **128** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **127** of them in the general wards. **One** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
