## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

#### **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of November 19<sup>th</sup> 2021, a total of **6,375,787** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,981,902** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were

**2,393,885**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **56.2%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **8.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**. Total Vaccines received to date are **10,704, 690**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **24.6%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **20.2%**, Kiambu **14.9%**, Taita Taveta and Laikipia **12.0%**. Nyandarua **11.2%**, Uasin Gishu **10.6%** and Muranga **10.3%** and Kirinyaga **10.0%**. While Garissa, Wajir, Tana River, Turkana, West Pokot, Mandera and Marsabit counties have less than **2%** of the population fully vaccinated.

The table below shows the proportion of those above 18 years who have received the first Dose of the COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi

county is on the lead with **35.7%** followed by Nyeri at **31.3%**, Kirinyaga at **23.4%**, Laikipia **23.3%**, Kiambu **21.7%** and Muranga at **20.9%**. Marsabit and Wajir counties are the least with **1.5%**, followed by Mandera having **1.9%** of the population receiving the first dose of the vaccine.

On the Covid-19 situation today **59** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,336** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.4%**. From the cases **57** are Kenyans while **two** are foreigners. **32** females and **27** are males. The youngest is a **four-year-old child** while the oldest is **80** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **254,688** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,794,810**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nyamira **14**, Nairobi **11**, Kakamega **4**, Kiambu **4**, Nakuru **3**, Kilifi **3**, Bungoma **3**, Busia **2**, Isiolo **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Kisii **2**, Nyandarua **1**, Nyeri **1**, Turkana **1**,

Kericho **1**, Baringo **1**, Kisumu **1**, Machakos **1**, Mandera **1** and Embu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**3**), 10-19 years (**0**), 20-29 years (**6**), 30-39 (**11**), 40-49 (**8**), 50-59 (**10**), 60 years and above (**21**).

Today **45** patients have recovered from the disease with **23** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **22** are from health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **247,919** of whom **200,218** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,701** are from various health facilities countrywide.

There is no death reported today. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,325**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(386)**, 40-49 years **(616)**, 50-59 years **(996)** 60 years and above **(3,088)**

A total of **354** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **985** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **21** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **9** of whom are on ventilatory support and **12** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **116** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **114** of them are in the general wards. **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
