PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of November 26th 2021, a total of **6,915,627** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **4,267,236** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were

2,648,391. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **57.2%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **9.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **26.9%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county at **21.3%**, Kiambu **15.9%**, Laikipia **13.6%**, Taita Taveta **12.8%**, Nyandarua **11.9%**, Murang'a **11.8%**, Uasin Gishu **11.4%**, Kirinyaga **10.9%**, Kisumu **10.7%** and Nakuru **10.5%**, Mombasa **10.3%**, Embu and Kajiado **10.0%**. Meanwhile, West Pokot, Turkana, Mandera and Marsabit have less than **2%** of the population fully vaccinated.

The table below shows the proportion of the above 18 years who have received the first Dose of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi

County is leading with **37.5%**, followed by Nyeri at **32.3%**, Laikipia **24.7%**, Kirinyaga **24.5%**, Kiambu **22.9%**, Murang'a at **22.3%**, Taita Taveta **22.1%** and Nyandarua **20.8%**. Mandera, Marsabit and Wajir are the least counties with less than **2%** of the population having received the first dose of the vaccine.

On the Covid-19 situation today **36** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,495** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.0%**. From the cases **33** are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners. **19** males and **17** are females. The youngest is a **thirteen-year-old child** while the oldest is **95** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **254,940** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,824,639**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nyamira **9**, Nakuru **7**, Kericho **4**, Nairobi **3**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Garissa **2**, West Pokot **2**, Kiambu **1**, Kisumu **1**, Lamu **1**, Mombasa **1**, Narok **1** and Trans Nzoia **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(5)**, 30-39 **(6)**, 40-49 **(11)**, 50-59 **(7)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today **31** patients have recovered from the disease with **28** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **3** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **248,116** of whom **200,364** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,752** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today there is no death reported. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,333**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(386)**, 40-49 years **(617)**, 50-59 years **(996)** 60 years and above **(3,095)**

A total of **353** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **969** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **15** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **6** of whom are on ventilatory support and **9** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **102** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **all** of them being in the general wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
