PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of November 29th 2021, a total of **7,063,927** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **4,354,454** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were

2,709,473. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **57.0%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **9.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033.**

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 27.3%, of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 21.6%, Kiambu 16.1%, Laikipia 14.0%, Taita Taveta 13.0%, Muranga 12.1%, Nyandarua 11.9%, Uasin Gishu 11.7%, Kirinyaga 11.1%, Kisumu 11.0%, Nakuru 10.7%. Mombasa 10.6%, Kajiado 10.6% and Embu 10.2%. While Turkana and Mandera had less than 2% of the population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **109** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,994** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.2%**. From the cases **91** are Kenyans while **18** are foreigners. **86** males and **23** are females. The youngest is a **five-year-old child** while the oldest is **91** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **255,088** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,835,065**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Trans Nzoia **64**, Nairobi **16**, Turkana **7**, Kakamega **6**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Mandera **2**, Mombasa **2**, Kericho **2**, Busia **1**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Garissa **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kisumu **1**, Machakos **1** and Taita Taveta **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(4)**, 10-19 years **(12)**, 20-29 years **(34)**, 30-39 **(15)**, 40-49 **(22)**, 50-59 **(15)**, 60 years and above **(7)**.

Today **10** patients have recovered from the disease with **5** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program and **5** from health

facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **248,318** of whom **200,400** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,918** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease being a late death reported after conducting facility audit records. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,335**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends that lost their loved one.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(386)**, 40-49 years **(617)**, 50-59 years **(996)** 60 years and above **(3,097)**

A total of **169** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **818** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **7** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **6** of whom are on ventilatory support and **1** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **50** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **all** of them being in the general wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
