**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of November 5<sup>th</sup> 2021, a total of **5,611,772** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,782,659** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,829,113**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **45.3%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **6.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with **19.7%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **17.4%**, Kiambu **10.9%**, Nyandarua **9.2%**, Uasin Gishu with **9.0%**, Kisumu **8.1%** and Mombasa **7.9%** while, Mandera, Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than **1%** of the population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **76** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,617** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.6%**. From the cases **70** are Kenyans and **6** foreigners. **45** males and **31** are females. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **93** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **253,813** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,735,256**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Kericho **14**, Kisii **12**, Nairobi **9**, Meru **5**, Busia **4**, Nyeri **4**, Nandi **4**, Kitui **3**, Kakamega **2**, Nakuru **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Bomet **2**, Bungoma **2**, Embu **1**, Machakos **1**,

Makueni **1**, Marsabit **1**, Migori **1**, Mombasa **1**, Murang'a **1**, Kajiado **1**, Trans Nzoia **1**, Turkana **1** and West Pokot **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**2**), 10-19 years (**3**), 20-29 years (**11**), 30-39 (**16**), 40-49 (**12**), 50-59 (**12**), 60 years and above (**20**).

Today **41** patients have recovered from the disease with **36** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **5** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **247,243** of whom **199,719** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,524** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **9** people have succumbed to the disease with one having occurred in the last 24 hours while the other **8** are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month

of September and November 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,305**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(2)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(2)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(141)**, 30-39 years **(383)**, 40-49 years **(615)**, 50-59 years **(992)** 60 years and above **(3,077)**

A total of **418** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,129** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **35** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **19** of whom are on ventilatory support and **16** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **119** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **117** of them in the general wards. **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
