PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of November 7th 2021, a total of **5,639,952** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,793,864** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,846,088**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **45.6%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **6.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with **20.0%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **17.4%**, Kiambu **10.9%**, Nyandarua **9.2%**, Uasin Gishu with **9.1%**, Kisumu **8.1%** and Mombasa **7.9%** while, Mandera, Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than **1%** of the population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **20** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,136** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%**. From the cases **19** are Kenyans and **one** foreigner. **11** males and **9** are females. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **89** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **253,853** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,741,836**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **8**, Nyeri **3**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Bungoma **1**, Embu **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kisumu **1**, Migori **1** and Murang'a **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(5)**, 30-39 **(5)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(3)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today **70** patients have recovered from the disease with **55** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **15** are from health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **247,370** of whom **199,830** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,540** are from various health facilities countrywide.

There is no death reported today. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain **5,312**.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(384)**, 40-49 years **(615)**, 50-59 years **(993)** 60 years and above **(3,081)**

A total of **402** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,093** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **33** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **18** of whom are on ventilatory support and **15** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **112** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **112** of them in the general wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
