PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of November 9th 2021, a total of **5,751,332** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,825,759** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,925,573**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **47.1%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **7.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **20.7%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **18.1%**, Kiambu **11.4%**, Taita Taveta and Nyandarua **9.6%** respectively, Uasin Gishu with **9.2%**, Kisumu **8.3%**, Kirinyaga **8.2%** and Mombasa **8.1%**. Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than **1%** of the population fully vaccinated.

The table below shows the proportion of the above 18 years who have received the first Dose of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi

County with **34.8%** followed by Kiambu at **30.4%**, Kirinyaga at **22.9%**, Kiambu **21.0%** and Muranga at **20.1%**. Marsabit County is the least county with **1.4%** followed by Wajir at **1.5%** and Mandera **1.9%** of the population receive dose 1 vaccination.

On the Covid-19 situation today **178** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **7,091** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.5%**. From the cases **173** are Kenyans while **five** are foreigners. **90** females and **88** are males. The youngest is a **two-month-old infant** while the oldest is **84** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **254,057** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,750,273**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **65**, Machakos **17**, Nakuru **15**, Kajiado **15**, Kiambu **11**, Kericho **8**, Meru **5**, Busia **5**, Nyamira **4**, Uasin Gishu **4**, Siaya **4**, Bungoma **3**, Mombasa **3**, Kisumu **2**,

Kitui **2**, Isiolo **2**, Kakamega **2**, Taita Taveta **2**, Kilifi **1**, Kisii **1**, Makueni **1**, Marsabit **1**, Nandi **1**, Garissa **1**, Vihiga **1**, Bomet **1** and West Pokot **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**13**), 10-19 years (**12**), 20-29 years (**29**), 30-39 (**52**), 40-49 (**26**), 50-59 (**19**), 60 years and above (**27**).

Today **31** patients have recovered from the disease with **25** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **6** are from health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **247,489** of whom **199,938** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,551** are from various health facilities countrywide.

There is no death reported today. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,314**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(384)**, 40-49 years **(616)**, 50-59 years **(993)** 60 years and above **(3,082)**

A total of **403** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,063** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **30** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **15** of whom are on ventilatory support and **15** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **111** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **110** of them are in the general wards. **One** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
