### UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE

#### Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- **16,201,670**
- 1<sup>st</sup> dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021
- Administration of 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose AstraZeneca began on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4<sup>th</sup> September 2021, Sinopharm 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2021 and Pfizer on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered Seven million, four hundred and seventeen thousand, two hundred and seventy-six (**7,417,276**) Those received first dose or partially vaccinated four million five hundred and thirty-nine thousand, nine hundred and twenty-eight (**4,539,928**), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) two million, eight hundred and seventy-seven thousand, three hundred and forty-eight persons (**2,877,348**) at 2<sup>nd</sup>, December 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday (Thursday) is **113,633** compared to the previous day (Wednesday) at **128,051** out of the total vaccinated **56,113** received Dose 1, while **57,520** received Dose 2 and JJ vaccine.

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county

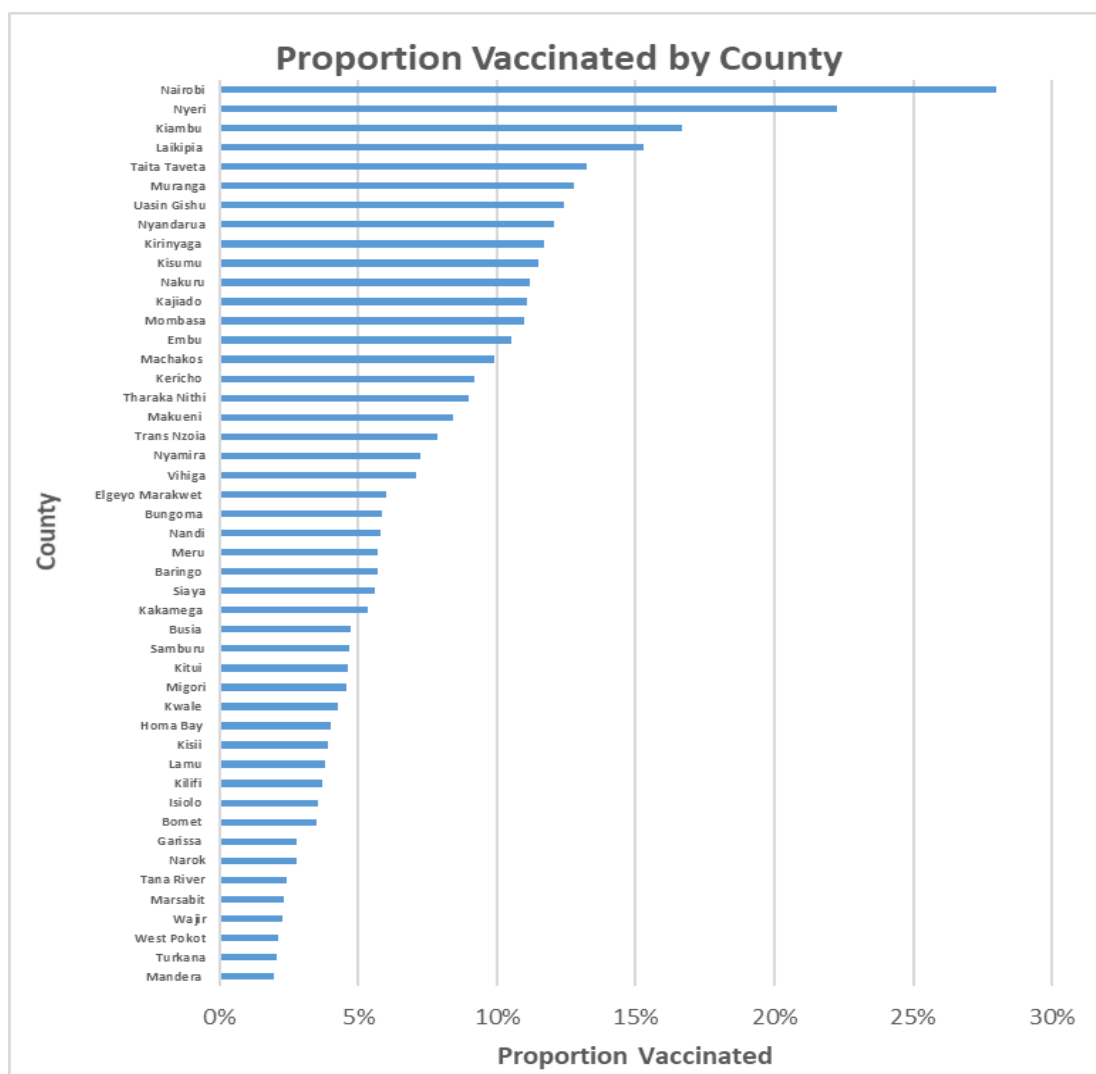

So far four Million eight hundred and nineteen thousand, and twenty-eight (4,819,028) persons have received at least one dose out of the target population of twenty-seven Million, two hundred and forty-six thousand and thirty-three (27,246,033) =17.7%

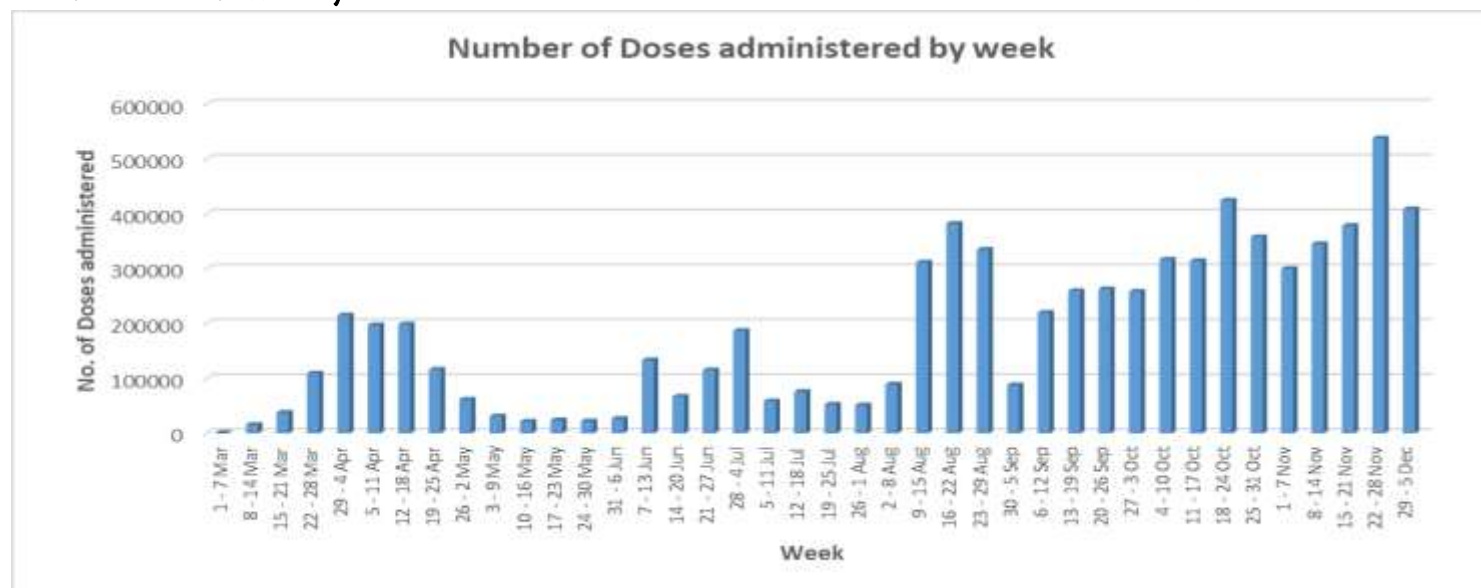
