UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **3,286** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **11,703** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **28.1%**. From the cases, **2,851** are Kenyans while

435 are foreigners. **1,648** are females and **1,638** are males. The youngest is an **eight-month-old child** while the oldest is **103** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **292,237** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,020,888**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **1,176**, Nakuru **237**, Mombasa **187**, Kiambu **133**, Nyandarua **127**, Migori **122**, Nyeri **115**, Uasin Gishu **114**, Siaya **110**, Bungoma **87**, Kisumu **86**, Kakamega **76**, Laikipia **61**, Makueni **54**, Tharaka Nithi **52**, Kilifi **52**, Murang'a **44**, Busia **33**, Baringo **32**, Kajiado **32**, Kisii **31**, Meru **29**, Kitui **27**, Kirinyaga **25**, Narok **23**, West Pokot **23**, Kwale **20**, Homa bay **20**, Embu **20**, Bomet **19**, Garissa **18**, Kericho **18**, Taita Taveta **16**, Vihiga **14**, Trans Nzoia **11**, Elgeyo Marakwet **9**, Nandi **7**, Machakos **7**, Marsabit **6**, Mandera **4**, Turkana **4**, Wajir **4** and Nyamira **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(91)**, 10-19 years **(209)**, 20-29 years **(669)**, 30-39 **(832)**, 40-49 **(614)**, 50-59 **(417)**, 60 years and above **(454)**.

Today **260** patients have recovered from the disease, **152** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **108** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **251,223** of whom **202,227** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **48,996** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **4** patients have succumbed to the disease, **one** in the last 24 hours while **3** are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of December 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,376**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(2)**, 50-59 years **(1)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(59)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(145)**, 30-39 years **(389)**, 40-49 years **(624)**, 50-59 years **(1,001)**, 60 years and above **(3,119)**.

A total of **935** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **22,771** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **41** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **20** of them on ventilatory support while **21** are on supplemental oxygen.

Another **207** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **182** of them are in the general wards. **25** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of December 29th 2021, a total of **9,849,459** vaccines have so far been administered across the country. Of these, **5,762,977** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **4,086,482**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **55.8%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **15.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **33.5%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri at **30.8%**, Laikipia **24.3%**, Kiambu **22.1%**, Taita Taveta **18.1%**, Kakamega **17.9%**, Murang'a **17.6%**, Uasin Gishu at **17.4%**, Machakos **16.8%**, Kirinyaga **16.6%**, Nyandarua **16.3%** Nakuru

15.8%, Kisumu 15.4% and Kajiado 15.2%.
