PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of December 13th 2021, a total of **8,223,238** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **4,947,002** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were

3,276,236. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **57.2%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **12.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **30.5%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri at **25.3%**, Kiambu **19.3%**, Laikipia **19.1%**, Murang'a **14.7%**, Uasin Gishu at **14.6%**, Taita Taveta **14.5%**, Kirinyaga **13.7%**, Nyandarua **13.2%**, Nakuru **13.1%**, Kajiado **12.9%**, Kisumu **12.8%** and Mombasa **12.5%**. Meanwhile, Wajir is among the counties with the least number of population fully vaccinated at **2.7%** and Mandera at **2.5%**.

So far, five Million **5,394,064** persons have received at least one dose, out of the target population of **27,246,033 (19.8%)**.

On the Covid-19 situation today **331** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,872** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **11.5%**. From the cases **296** are Kenyans while **35** are foreigners. **178** females and **153** are males. The youngest is a **five-month-old child** while the oldest

is **99** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **256,815** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,894,765**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **284**, Kiambu **10**, Kakamega **7**, Nakuru **7**, Kajiado **6**, Machakos **3**, Migori **3**, Baringo **2**, Busia **2**, Embu **2**, Laikipia **2**, Kirinyaga **1**, Taita Taveta **1** and Uasin Gishu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(13)**, 10-19 years **(23)**, 20-29 years **(72)**, 30-39 **(120)**, 40-49 **(57)**, 50-59 **(28)**, 60 years and above **(18)**.

Today **253** patients have recovered from the disease, **237** are from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **16** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **248,804** of whom **200,783** are from the Home-Based

Care and Isolation program, while **48,021** are from various health facilities countrywide.

There is no death reported today. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,349**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**58**), 10-19 years (**39**), 20-29 (**144**), 30-39 years (**386**), 40-49 years (**620**), 50-59 years (**998**), 60 years and above (**3,104**).

A total of **161** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **710** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **2** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), and all of them are on ventilatory support.

A total of **43** patients are on supplemental oxygen with **42** of them being in the general wards. **One** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
