## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

#### **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of December 6<sup>th</sup> 2021, a total of **7,678,464** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **4,676,556** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **3,001,908**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **57.2%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **11.0%**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **28.9%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri **23.4%**, Kiambu **18.0%**, Laikipia **17.0%**, Taita Taveta **13.9%**, Murang'a **13.7%**, Uasin Gishu **13.5%**, Kirinyaga **12.5%**, Nyandarua **12.4%**, Kisumu **12.1%**, Nakuru **12.0%**, Kajiado **11.8%** and Mombasa **11.6%**. While Marsabit and Tana River are among the least with **2.7%**, Wajir, Turkana and West Pokot each with **2.4%** and Mandera at **2.2%** of the Population fully vaccinated.

of Johnson and Johnson vaccine and first dose of other vaccines) as at 4<sup>th</sup> December 2021. So far **5,003,403** persons have received at least one dose out of the target population of **27,246,033 =18.4%.**

On the Covid-19 situation today **75** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,771** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.6%**. From the cases **60** are Kenyans while **15** are foreigners. **50** males and **25** are females. The youngest is a **13-year-old** while the oldest is **79** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **255,544** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,863,425**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **26**, Kakamega **10**, Kericho **5**, Nakuru **5**, Trans Nzoia **5**, Kiambu **4**, Mombasa **3**,

Turkana **3**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Busia **2**, Nyeri **2**, Bungoma **1**, Homa Bay **1**, Kitui **1**, Migori **1**, Nandi **1**, Narok **1**, Taita Taveta **1**, Bomet **1**,

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(9)**, 20-29 years **(12)**, 30-39 **(23)**, 40-49 **(11)**, 50-59 **(5)**, 60 years and above **(15)**.

Today **8** patients have recovered from the disease with **5** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program and **3** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **248,452** of whom **200,483** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,969** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **two** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audit. This pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,337**. Our sincere

condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(386)**, 40-49 years **(617)**, 50-59 years **(996)** 60 years and above **(3,099)**

A total of **207** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **844** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **2** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **2** of whom are on ventilatory support.

A total of **52** patients are on supplemental oxygen with **50** of them being in the general wards. **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
