PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of December 8th 2021, a total of **7,893,165** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **4,776,131** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **3,117,034**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **57.5%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **11.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **29.5%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri at **24.3%**, Kiambu **18.6%**, Laikipia **18.1%**, Murang'a **14.3%**, Taita Taveta **14.1%**, Uasin Gishu **14.0%**, Kirinyaga **13.0%**, Nyandarua **12.7%**, Kisumu **12.5%**, Nakuru **12.5%**, Kajiado **12.3%**, and Mombasa **12.0%**. Meanwhile, Tana River is among the counties with the least number of population fully vaccinated with **2.8%** followed by Turkana at **2.7%**, West Pokot **2.6%**, Wajir **2.5%**, and Mandera **2.3%**.

The table below shows the proportion of the above 18 years' population who have received at least one dose of Covid-19 vaccine (A dose of Johnson and Johnson vaccine and first dose of other vaccines) as at Wednesday 8th, December 2021. So far, **5,148,309** persons have received at least one dose, out of the target population of **27,246,033 (18.9%)**.

On the Covid-19 situation today **144** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,897** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.4%**. From the cases **129** are Kenyans while **15** are foreigners. **81** males and **63** are females. The youngest is a **7-year-old child** while the oldest is **89** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **255,796** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,874,395**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **85**, Kisii **8**, Trans Nzoia **8**, Nakuru **6**, Kiambu **4**, Machakos **4**, Kajiado **4**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Kericho **3**, Busia **3**, Migori **2**, Lamu **2**, Isiolo **1**, Kakamega **1**, Kilifi **1**, Kirinyaga **1**, Kisumu **1**, Nyamira **1**, Nyandarua **1**, Nyeri **1**, Siaya **1**, West Pokot **1**, Baringo **1** and Embu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**3**), 10-19 years (**8**), 20-29 years (**40**), 30-39 (**32**), 40-49 (**33**), 50-59 (**13**), 60 years and above (**15**).

Today **7** patients have recovered from the disease with **6** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **1** is from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **248,480** of whom **200,507** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,973** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **two** patients have succumbed to the disease, one having occurred in the last 24 hours while the other is a late death recorded after conducting facility report audits. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,339**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(1)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(386)**, 40-49 years **(618)**, 50-59 years **(996)** 60 years and above **(3,100)**

A total of **204** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **833** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **2** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), and all of them are on ventilatory support.

A total of **50** patients are on supplemental oxygen with **48** of them being in the general wards. **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
