## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JANUARY 2, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **1,354** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,331** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **25.4%**. From the cases **1,102** are Kenyans while **252**

are foreigners. **687** are males and **667** are females. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **105** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **298,509** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,042,313**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **551**, Migori **140**, Turkana **80**, Nyeri **75**, Kilifi **59**, Siaya **56**, Nakuru **46**, Kiambu **46**, Kakamega **40**, Mombasa **36**, Uasin Gishu **34**, Machakos **28**, Murang'a **22**, Kisumu **17**, Kwale **17**, Kitui **15**, Garissa **12**, West Pokot **10**, Meru **10**, Laikipia **10**, Homa Bay **8**, Makueni **7**, Kajiado **7**, Embu **7**, Lamu **4**, Taita Taveta **4**, Busia **4**, Bomet **3**, Kericho **3**, Trans Nzoia **1**, Vihiga **1** and Nandi **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(57)**, 10-19 years **(100)**, 20-29 years **(205)**, 30-39 **(309)**, 40-49 **(244)**, 50-59 **(160)**, 60 years and above **(279)**.

Today **400** patients have recovered from the disease, **216** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **184** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **254,115** of whom **204,806** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **49,309** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,384**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(1)**, 50-59 years **(1)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**59**), 10-19 years (**39**), 20-29 (**145**), 30-39 years (**391**), 40-49 years (**625**), 50-59 years (**1,002**) 60 years and above (**3,123**)

A total of **1,029** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **23,667** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **53** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **21** of them on ventilatory support while **26** are on supplemental oxygen. **6** patients are under observation.

Another **271** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **248** of them are in the general wards. **23** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

### **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, a total of **10,121,263** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **5,871,177** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **4,215,806**. Another **21,065** are doses administered to those between 15 to 18 years while **13,215** are booster doses. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **55.8%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **15.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. The top 10 counties are; Nairobi is in the lead with **34.2%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri **31.6%**, Laikipia **25.1%**, Kiambu **22.5%**, Kakamega **19.3%**, Taita Taveta **18.5%**, Murang'a **18.0%**, Uasin Gishu **17.8%**, Machakos **17.2%**, Kirinyaga **17.1%** and Nyandarua at **17.0%**.
