UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **2,216** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **8,669** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **25.6%**. From the cases, **1,984** are Kenyans while **232**

are foreigners. **1,124** are males and **1,092** are females. The youngest is a **two-month-old child** while the oldest is **105** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **304,350** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,065,623**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **861**, Siaya **149**, Nakuru **119**, Kiambu **99**, Kitui **99**, Nyamira **94**, Uasin Gishu **80**, Laikipia **67**, Mombasa **67**, Migori **56**, Turkana **55**, Kericho **54**, Kakamega **49**, Kilifi **35**, Kisumu **33**, Nyeri **28**, Kirinyaga **27**, Murang'a **24**, Nyandarua **22**, Kajiado **20**, Homa Bay **17**, Bungoma **16**, Taita Taveta **16**, Embu **15**, Baringo **13**, Tharaka Nithi **13**, Makueni **11**, Nandi **11**, Lamu **9**, West Pokot **8**, Busia **8**, Garissa **7**, Machakos **7**, Meru **5**, Marsabit **4**, Narok **4**, Elgeyo Marakwet **3**, Trans Nzoia **3**, Wajir **3**, Kisii **2**, Bomet **1**, Kwale **1** and Vihiga **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(112)**, 10-19 years **(175)**, 20-29 years **(400)**, 30-39 **(478)**, 40-49 **(366)**, 50-59 **(262)**, 60 years and above **(423)**.

Today **775** patients have recovered from the disease, **578** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **197** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **259,308** of whom **209,648** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **49,660** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of January 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,404**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(1)**, 50-59 years **(1)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(59)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(145)**, 30-39 years **(392)**, 40-49 years **(630)**, 50-59 years **(1,005)**, 60 years and above **(3,134)**.

A total of **1,226** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **25,969** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **51** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **27** of them on ventilatory support while **18** are on supplemental oxygen. **6** patients are under observation.

Another **328** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **292** of them are in the general wards. **36** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of January 4th 2022, a total of **10,310,606** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **5,942,632** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **4,321,150**. Another **22,885** are doses administered to those between 15 to 18 years while **23,939** are booster doses. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **56.1%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **15.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. The top 10 counties are; Nairobi is in the lead with **34.7%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri at **32.2%**, Laikipia **25.6%**, Kiambu **22.9%**, Kakamega **20.2%**, Taita Taveta **18.7%**, Murang'a and Uasin Gishu at **18.2%** respectively, Machakos **17.5%**, Kirinyaga and Nyandarua

at **17.4%** respectively.
