PRESS STATEMENT

Today **624** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **7,045** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **8.9%**. From the cases, **560** are Kenyans while **64** are

foreigners. **330** males and **294** are females. The youngest is a **four-month-old child** while the oldest is **97** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **317,324** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,143,862**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **216**, Siaya **64**, Nakuru **48**, Kiambu **34**, Mombasa **29**, Nyeri **27**, Bungoma **18**, Meru **18**, Uasin Gishu **13**, Busia **12**, Kilifi **12**, Nyamira **10**, Kajiado **9**, Murang'a **9**, Nyandarua **9**, Isiolo **7**, Kakamega **7**, Makueni **7**, Marsabit **7**, Kericho **6**, Kirinyaga **6**, Kisumu **6**, Turkana **6**, Laikipia **4**, West Pokot **4**, Baringo **3**, Kitui **3**, Machakos **3**, Nandi **3**, Tharaka Nithi **3**, Trans Nzoia **3**, Elgeyo Marakwet **2**, Garissa **2**, Homa Bay **2**, Kisii **2**, Kwale **2**, Samburu **2**, Bomet **1**, Embu **1**, Lamu **1**, Migori **1**, Narok **1** and Vihiga **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(56)**, 10-19 years **(52)**, 20-29 years **(69)**, 30-39 **(110)**, 40-49 **(102)**, 50-59 **(77)**, 60 years and above **(158)**.

Today **1,144** patients have recovered from the disease, **929** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **215** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **281,343** of whom **230,257** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **51,086** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **6** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of January 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,488**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(59)**, 10-19 years **(42)**, 20-29 **(148)**, 30-39 years **(396)**, 40-49 years **(633)**, 50-59 years **(1,009)**, 60 years and above **(3,201)**.

A total of **1,059** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **13,993** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **43** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **41** of them on ventilatory support while **two** are on supplemental oxygen.

Another **220** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **215** of them are in the general wards. **5** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of January 14th 2022, a total of **11,067,257** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **6,193,498** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **4,756,375**. Another **28,951** are doses administered to those between 15 to 18 years while **88,433** are booster doses. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **17.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
