PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of February 15th 2022, a total of **15,786,496** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,553,155** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,186,675**.

Another 795,531 are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **235,123** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **125,082** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **62,814**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.0%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **26.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **28** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,617** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.5%**. From the cases, **19** are Kenyans while **9** are foreigners. **15** are females while **13** males. The youngest is aged **14-years** while the oldest is **82** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,545** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,310,294**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **15**, Nakuru **5**, Kiambu **2**, Kwale **2**, Makueni **1**, Migori **1**, Siaya **1** and Turkana **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(6)**, 30-39 **(8)**, 40-49 **(2)**, 50-59 **(4)**, 60 years and above **(6)**.

Today **52** patients have recovered from the disease, **40** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **12** are from the various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **302,918** of whom **250,119** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,799** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease and it's a late death report after conducting facility audit records in February, 2022. Therefore, this pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,633**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends that have lost their loved one.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(408)**, 40-49 years **(643)**, 50-59 years **(1,026)**, 60 years and above **(3,298)**.

A total of **150** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **628** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **3** of them on ventilatory support and **1** on supplemental oxygen. Another **28** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **25** of them are in the general wards, while **three** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
