PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of February 18th 2022, a total of **16,099,006** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,642,960** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,334,529**.

Another **863,850** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **240,871** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **50,826** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **28,505**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.3%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **26.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **29** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,547** tested in the last 24 hours.

The positivity rate is now at **0.5%**. From the cases, **20** are Kenyans while **9** are foreigners. **15** females while **14** are males. The youngest is an **18-year-old** while the oldest is **84** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,669** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,327,872**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **15**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Busia **2**, Kisumu **2**, Mombasa **2**, Kiambu **1**, Migori **1**, Muranga **1**, Nandi **1** and Nyandarua **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(6)**, 30-39 **(5)**, 40-49 **(8)**, 50-59 **(6)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today **44** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **303,010** of whom **250,158** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,852** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **2** patients have succumbed to the disease in the last 24 hours pushing cumulative fatalities to **5,635**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those that have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**408**), 40-49 years (**644**), 50-59 years (**1,026**), 60 years and above (**3,299**).

A total of **109** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **594** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support. Another **22** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
