PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of February 21st 2022, a total of **16,222,224** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,682,428** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,384,860**.

Another **894,784** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **242,801** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **40,695** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **23,842**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.3%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **27.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **34** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,136** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.7%**. From the cases, **29** are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners. **17** males while **17** are females. The youngest is a **5-year-old child** while the oldest is **105** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,736** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,341,048**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **21**, Vihiga **3**, Kilifi **2**, Nakuru **2**, Siaya **2**, Busia **1**, Garissa **1**, Kisumu **1** and Nyeri **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(3)**, 20-29 years **(6)**, 30-39 **(11)**, 40-49 **(2)**, 50-59 **(4)**, 60 years and above **(7)**.

Today **no** patients have been reported to have recovered from the disease. Therefore, the total recoveries remain **303,107** of whom **250,218** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,889** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today, there is no death reported, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,638**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**408**), 40-49 years (**644**), 50-59 years (**1,027**), 60 years and above (**3,301**).

A total of **94** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **554** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **5** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support. Another **21** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
