**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of January 31<sup>st</sup> 2022, a total of **12,451,246** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **6,583,334** are partially

vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **5,634,410**. Another **78,066** are doses administered to those between 15 to 18 years while **155,436** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **198,672** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **113,698**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.2%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **20.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **171** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,137** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.8%**. From the cases, **131** are Kenyans while **40** are foreigners. **89** are females and **82** are males. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **92** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **321,552** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,229,023**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **124**, Uasin Gishu **7**, Siaya **6**, Nakuru **5**, Bomet **3**, Kiambu **3**, Kakamega **3**, Garissa **2**, Homa Bay **2**, Kisumu **2**, Mombasa **2**, Nyamira **2**, Embu **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kwale **1**, Makueni **1**, Murang'a **1**, Nyandarua **1**, Nyeri **1**, Taita Taveta **1**, Trans Nzoia **1** and Elgeyo Marakwet **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(8)**, 10-19 years **(8)**, 20-29 years **(30)**, 30-39 **(39)**, 40-49 **(32)**, 50-59 **(26)**, 60 years and above **(28)**.

Today **137** patients have recovered from the disease, **112** are from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **25** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **294,859** of whom **242,384** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,475** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **4** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of January 2022. Therefore, this pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,587**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(42)**, 20-29 **(148)**, 30-39 years **(399)**, 40-49 years **(640)**, 50-59 years **(1,018)**, 60 years and above **(3,278)**.

A total of **413** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,545** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **10** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and all of them are on ventilatory support. Another **89** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **87** of them are in the general wards while **two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
