**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

In the last 24 hours, the Ministry of Health has managed to vaccinate a record **249,772** people in the country. This follows the mass vaccination drive that was launched yesterday in conjunction

with the Ministry of Interior and Coordination of National Government.

As of February 3<sup>rd</sup> 2022, a total of **13,134,929** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **6,773,782** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **6,014,919**. Another **169,910** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **176,318** are booster doses.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.6%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **22.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **158** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,899** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.3%**. From the cases, **143** are Kenyans while **15** are foreigners. **88** males and **70** are females. The youngest is an **five-month-old child** while the oldest is **100** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **321,922** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,247,589**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Kitui **73**, Nairobi **20**, Trans Nzoia **12**, Nakuru **7**, Machakos **6**, Mombasa **6**, Nyamira **4**, Nyandarua **3**, Uasin Gishu **3**, West Pokot **2**, Bungoma **2**, Kilifi **2**, Kwale **2**, Laikipia **2**, Nandi **2**, Siaya **2**, Turkana **1**, Kisumu **1**, Busia **1**, Marsabit **1**,

Murang'a **1**, Nyeri **1**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Garissa **1**, Homa Bay **1** and Kakamega **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**8**), 10-19 years (**15**), 20-29 years (**12**), 30-39 (**26**), 40-49 (**22**), 50-59 (**23**), 60 years and above (**52**).

Today **46** patients have recovered from the disease, **37** are from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **9** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **295,580** of whom **243,021** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,559** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today no death has been reported. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain **5,604**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(42)**, 20-29 **(148)**, 30-39 years **(402)**, 40-49 years **(642)**, 50-59 years **(1,022)**, 60 years and above **(3,283)**.

A total of **352** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,028** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **9** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), and all of them are on ventilatory support. Another **70** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **68** of them are in the general wards. **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
