**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of February 6<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **13,782,963** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **6,965,069** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **6,338,847**. Another

**285,456** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **193,591** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **150,632** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **83,833**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.3%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **23.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **55** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,216** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.7%**. From the cases, **37** are Kenyans while **18** are foreigners. **34** are males and **21** are females. The youngest is a **six-month-old child** while the oldest is **92** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,151** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,261,313**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **47**, Nyeri **3**, Mombasa **2**, Kiambu **1**, Kisii **1** and Laikipia **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(3)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(13)**, 30-39 **(19)**, 40-49 **(7)**, 50-59 **(7)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Today **137** patients have recovered from the disease, **121** are from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **16** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **296,108** of whom **243,493** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,615** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today there is no death reported. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,621**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(42)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(405)**, 40-49 years **(642)**, 50-59 years **(1,025)**, 60 years and above **(3,293)**.

A total of **242** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **3,619** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **8** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **7** of them are on ventilatory support and **1** on supplemental oxygen. Another **58** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **56** of them are in the general wards while **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
