PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of February 13th 2022, a total of **15,437,589** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,455,519** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,027,862**.

Another **725,567** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **228,641** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **159,235** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **72,843**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **62.9%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **25.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **24** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,050** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%**. From the cases, **20** are Kenyans while **4** are foreigners. **15** are males while **9** are females. The youngest is a **five-year-old child** while the oldest is **72** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,497** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,299,132**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **14**, Machakos **3**, Mombasa **3**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Kilifi **1**, Kwale **1** and Uasin Gishu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(7)**, 50-59 **(8)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today **85** patients have recovered from the disease, **67** are of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while 18 are from the various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **302,829** of whom **250,047** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,782** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **1** patient has succumbed to the disease, and it is a late death reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of February 2022. Therefore, this pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,632**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved one.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(407)**, 40-49 years **(643)**, 50-59 years **(1,026)**, 60 years and above **(3,298)**.

A total of **161** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **679** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **3** of them on ventilatory support and **1** on supplemental oxygen. Another **31** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **28** of them are in the general wards, while **three** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
