### **PRESS STATEMENT**

#### **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of February 16<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **15,911,717** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,588,728** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,245,768**.

Another **839,918** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **237,303** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **82,954** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **45,567**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.1%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **26.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **69** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,352** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.1%**. From the cases, **54** are Kenyans while **15** are foreigners. **46** males while **23** are females. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **94** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,614** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,316,646**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **19**, Nakuru **15**, Trans Nzoia **10**, Nandi **4**, Busia **3**, Mombasa **3**, Kwale **2**, Machakos **2**, Makueni **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Nyandarua **1**, Siaya **1**, West Pokot **1**, Bungoma **1**, Garissa **1**, Kericho **1** and Kisii **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(5)**, 10-19 years **(3)**, 20-29 years **(8)**, 30-39 **(18)**, 40-49 **(12)**, 50-59 **(10)**, 60 years and above **(13)**.

Today **19** patients have recovered from the disease, **12** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **7** are from the various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **302,937** of whom **250,131** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,806** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today no death has been reported therefore the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,633**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(408)**, 40-49 years **(643)**, 50-59 years **(1,026)**, 60 years and above **(3,298)**.

A total of **139** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **618** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support.

Another **24** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
