PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of February 19th 2022, a total of **16,130,662** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,653,579** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,344,620**.

Another **891,366** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **241,097** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **12,337** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **4,596**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.3%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **27.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **27** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,151** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.5%**. From the cases, **22** are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners. **21** are males while **6** are females. The youngest is a **7-year-old** while the oldest is **104** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,696** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,333,023**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **14**, Nakuru **10**, Kajiado **1**, Kilifi **1** and Mombasa **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(8)**, 40-49 **(6)**, 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Today **69** patients have recovered from the disease, **53** of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care while **16** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **303,079** of whom **250,211** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,868** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today no death has been reported, therefore the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,635**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(408)**, 40-49 years **(644)**, 50-59 years **(1,026)**, 60 years and above **(3,299)**.

A total of **100** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **556** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support. Another **22** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
