**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of February 25<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **16,533,328** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,780,274** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,539,852**.

Another **962,722** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **250,480** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **55,886** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **30,617**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.7%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **27.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **37** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,894** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%**. From the cases, **23** are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **24** are males while **13** are females. The youngest is a **5-year-old child** while the oldest is **83** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,906** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,363,604**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **18**, Bungoma **4**, Nakuru **4**, Uasin Gishu **4**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kilifi **1**, Machakos **1**, Trans Nzoia **1**, Mombasa **1** and Nandi **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(3)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(2)**, 30-39 **(10)**, 40-49 **(11)**, 50-59 **(4)**, 60 years and above **(7)**.

Today **10** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **303,208** of whom **250,268** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,940** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease which is a late death reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of February 2022. This pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,639**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved one.

A total of **40** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **537** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support.

Another **13** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
