**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of January 30<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **12,252,574** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **6,521,728** are partially

vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **5,520,712**. Another **61,437** are doses administered to those between 15 to 18 years while **148,697** are booster doses.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.0%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **20.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated.

Today **46** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,324** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.0%**. From the cases, **41** are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners. **23** are males and **23** are females. The youngest is a **three-year-old child** while the oldest is **91** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **321,381** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,222,886**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **33**, Nyeri **3**, Siaya **2**, Nyandarua **2**, Uasin Gishu **1**, Bomet **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kirinyaga **1**, Meru **1** and Mombasa **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(3)**, 20-29 years **(5)**, 30-39 **(10)**, 40-49 **(9)**, 50-59 **(10)**, 60 years and above **(8)**.

Today **107** patients have recovered from the disease, **93** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **14** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **294,722** of whom **242,272** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,450** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease, **one** of them in the last 24 hours, while the other **two** are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of January 2022. Therefore, this pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,583**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those that have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**61**), 10-19 years (**42**), 20-29 (**148**), 30-39 years (**399**), 40-49 years (**640**), 50-59 years (**1,018**), 60 years and above (**3,275**).

A total of **438** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,602** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **11** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), and all of them are on ventilatory support. Another **92** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **90** of them are in the general wards while **two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
