PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of February 28th 2022, a total of **16,691,191** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,838,509** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,611,589**.

Another **986,758** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **254,335** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **53,053** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **32,094**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.7%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **27.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **32** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,480** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%**. From the cases, **25** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **21** are males while **11** are females. The youngest is a **three-year-old child** while the oldest is **62** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **322,978** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,376,678**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **27**, Mombasa **3** and Turkana **2**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(4)**, 30-39 **(9)**, 40-49 **(9)**, 50-59 **(7)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today **13** patients have recovered from the disease, **10** from various health facilities countrywide while **3** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **303,274** of whom **250,295** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,979** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today there is no death reported, therefore the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,639**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**644**), 50-59 years (**1,027**), 60 years and above (**3,305**).

A total of **39** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **496** are under the Home-Based

Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support.

Another **14** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
