PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of March 2nd 2022, a total of **16,786,825** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,858,965** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,662,349**. Another

1,008,785 are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **256,726** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **34,362** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **25,169**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.9%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **28.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **23** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,517** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.4%**. From the cases, **13** are Kenyans while **10** are foreigners. **13** are females while **10** are males. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **94** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,025** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,387,151**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **21**, Baringo **1** and Garissa **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(3)**, 20-29 years **(8)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today we do not have any patients who have been discharged. Therefore, the total recoveries remain **303,296** of whom **250,314** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,982** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Also today there is no death reported, therefore the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,640**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**644**), 50-59 years (**1,027**), 60 years and above (**3,306**).

A total of **39** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **483** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support.

Another **14** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of March 1st 2022, a total of **16,740,060** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,850,174** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,636,280**. Another **966,490** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **255,481** are booster doses

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **34,763** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **24,339**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **63.8%**. Proportion of

adults fully vaccinated was **28.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **24** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,956** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate

is now at **0.5%**. From the cases all the **24** are Kenyans. **17** males while **7** are females. The youngest is a **seven-year-old child** while the oldest is **81** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,002** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,381,634**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **8**, Mandera **5**, Nakuru **4**, Kiambu **2**, Nyeri **2**, Embu, Migori and Turkana **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(5)**, 30-39 **(6)**, 40-49 **(6)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today **13** patients have recovered from the disease, **10** from various health facilities countrywide while **3** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **303,274** of whom **250,295** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **52,979** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, one patient has succumbed to the disease which is a late death reported in February 2022. This pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,640**. Our sincere condolence to the family and friends that lost their loved one.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**644**), 50-59 years (**1,027**), 60 years and above (**3,305**).

A total of **39** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **483** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **all** of them are on ventilatory support. Another **14** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
