PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of March 5th 2022, a total of **16,876,436** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,879,179** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,709,875**. Another

1,028,336 are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **259,046** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,038** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **3,653**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **64.1%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **28.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **4** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,956** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.1%**. From the cases, **all** the **4** are Kenyans. **2** are males while **2** are females. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **42** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,075** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,403,120**.

In terms of **County** distribution; All the **4** cases are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(1)**, 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today **23** patients have recovered from the disease, **22** of them from Home Based and Isolation Care while **one** is from a health facility in the country. This pushes the total recoveries to **303,352** of whom **250,363** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,989** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease which is a late death reported in February 2022. This pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,641**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**644**), 50-59 years (**1,027**), 60 years and above (**3,307**).

A total of **35** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **452** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **is** on ventilatory support.

Another **7** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
