PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of March 11th 2022, a total of **17,105,662** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,918,233** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,823,667**. Another

1,099,997 are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **263,765** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **41,929** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **20,199**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **64.8%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **28.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **11** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,218** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.2%**. From the cases, **6** are foreigners while **5** are Kenyans. **7** are males while **4** are females. The youngest is a **31 year-old** while the oldest is **60** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,171** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,434,544**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **5**, Machakos **2**, Nakuru **2**, Kajiado **1** and Turkana **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(4)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today **198** patients have recovered from the disease, **194** of them from Home Based and Isolation Care while **4** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,665** of whom **264,666** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **52,999** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today no death has been reported. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,644**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(646)**, 50-59 years **(1,027)**, 60 years and above **(3,308)**.

A total of **22** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **194** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **is** on ventilatory support.

Another **4** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
