PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of March 12th 2022, a total of **17,118,224** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,922,091** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,830,041**. Another

1,102,104 are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **263,988** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **8,518** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **4,678**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **64.8%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **28.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **12** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,672** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.2%**. From the cases, all the **12** are Kenyans. **8** are males while **4** are females. The youngest is a **7-year-old child** while the oldest is **62** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,183** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,440,216**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **11** and Kiambu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(3)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today **1** patient has recovered from the disease, and is from a health facility in the country. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,491** of whom **264,491** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,000** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **1** patient has succumbed to the disease and is a late death reported after conducting facility audit records in February 2022. Therefore, this pushes the cumulative fatalities **5,645**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends that lost their loved one.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**646**), 50-59 years (**1,027**), 60 years and above (**3,309**).

A total of **21** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **194** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and **is** on ventilatory support.

Another **4** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
