PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of March 14th 2022, a total of **17,172,651** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,932,686** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,854,320**. Another

1,120,622 are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **265,023** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **33,094** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **11,284**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **64.9%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **28.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **9** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,151** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.2%**. From the cases, **8** are Kenyans and **one** foreigner. **5** are males while **4** are females. The youngest is a **31-year-old** while the oldest is **91** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,204** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,448,106**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **6**, Nakuru, Nyeri and Turkana **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(1)**, 50-59 **(3)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **12** patients have recovered from the disease and all of them are from the Home-Based and Isolation Care. Therefore, this pushes the total recoveries to **317,503** of whom **264,503** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,000** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **1** patient has succumbed to the disease and is a late death reported after conducting facility record audits in March 2022. Therefore, this pushes the cumulative fatalities **5,647**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,028)**, 60 years and above **(3,309)**.

A total of **21** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **129** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and is on ventilatory support.

Another **4** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
