**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of March 21<sup>st</sup> 2022, a total of **17,374,904** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **7,967,097** are partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated are **7,958,138**. Another

**1,178,671** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **270,998** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **27,614** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **16,792**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **29.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **17** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,480** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.4%**. From the cases, **14** are Kenyans and **3** are foreigners. **12** are males while **5** females. The youngest is a **12-year-old** while the oldest is **62** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,306** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,478,182**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **14**, Nyeri **2** and Mombasa **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(4)**, 50-59 **(4)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **2** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them are from our health facilities in the country. Therefore, this pushes the total recoveries to **317,508** of whom **264,505** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,003** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today, **no** death has been reported, therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,647**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,028)**, 60 years and above **(3,309)**.

A total of **20** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **113** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). **3** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
