PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of March 23rd 2022, a total of **17,439,578** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **15,974,499** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,192,103** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **272,976** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **21,901**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **29.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **14** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,307** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.3%**. From the cases, **9** are foreigners and **5** are Kenyans. **8** are females while **6** are males. The youngest is a **19-year-old** while the oldest is **67** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,333** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,487,114**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **8**, Mombasa **2**, Nakuru **2**, Kilifi **1** and Siaya **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today, **2** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from various health facilities in the country. Therefore, this pushes the total recoveries to **317,536** of whom **264,522** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,014** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Today, **no** death has been reported, therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,647**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,028)**, 60 years and above **(3,309)**.

A total of **11** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **96** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **One** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and also on ventilatory support. **3** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
