**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of March 27<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **17,535,200** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,049,239** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,209,464** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **276,497** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **12,331** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,365**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **29.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **9** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,255** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.3%**. From the cases, **7** are Kenyans and **2** foreigners. **5** are females while **4** are males. The youngest is a **5-year-old child** while the oldest is **62** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,383** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,502,787**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **7**, Busia **1**, Machakos **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(5)**, 40-49 **(0)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **18** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,608** of whom **264,594** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,014** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** death has been reported, therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,647**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,028**), 60 years and above (**3,309**).

A total of **13** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **115** are under the Home-Based

Isolation and Care program. **One** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and also on ventilatory support. **3** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
