**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of March 28<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **17,565,944** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,074,373** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,214,136** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **277,435** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **25,555** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **18,214**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **29.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **12** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,661** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.3%**. From the cases, **8** are Kenyans and **4** foreigners. **7** are females while **5** are males. The youngest is a **3-year-old child** while the oldest is **63** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,395** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,507,448**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **11** and Meru **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **16** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,624** of whom **264,610** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,014** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease and it is a late death reported after auditing of facility records in the month of March 2022. This pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,648**. Our condolences to the family and friends who have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,309)**.

A total of **13** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **110** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **One** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and also on ventilatory support. **3** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
