**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of March 29<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **17,595,442** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,098,398** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,218,485** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **278,559** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **23,742** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **16,821**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **29.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **7** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,166** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.2%**. From the cases, **all the 7** are Kenyans. **5** are males while **2** are females. The youngest is a **5-year-old child** while the oldest is **53** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,402** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,511,614**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **6** and Uasin Gishu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(1)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **9** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,633** of whom **264,619** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,014** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** death has been reported and therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,648**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,309**).

A total of **13** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **108** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). **2** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them

are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
