**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

**PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **5** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,326** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.2%**. From the cases all the **5** are Kenyans. **3** males while **2** are females. The youngest is an **18-year-old**

while the oldest is **64** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,723** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,588,732**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **3**, Garissa and Kakamega **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(0)**, 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **4** patients have recovered from the disease and all of them are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,923** of whom **264,896** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,027** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,310**).

A total of **2** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **138** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **1** patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
