**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of April 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, a total of **17,661,337** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,154,273** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,225,479** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **281,585** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **12,716** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **9,234**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **29.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **14** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,313** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.3%**. From the cases, **9** are foreigners while **5** are Kenyans. **11** are males while **3** are females. The youngest is an **8-year-old child** while the oldest is **79** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,450** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,524,639**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **10** and Busia, Kiambu, Mandera and Turkana **1 case each**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(4)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today, **13** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,671** of whom **264,656** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,015** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** death has been reported and therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,648**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,309)**.

A total of **12** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **119** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). **2** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
