PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of April 2nd 2022, a total of **17,665,765** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,158,450** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,225,559** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **281,756** are booster doses

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **2,363** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **1,716**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **29.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **4** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,488** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.2%**. From the cases, **3** are Kenyans while **one** is a foreigner. **2** are males while **2** are females. The youngest is a **38-year-old** while the oldest is **65** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,454** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,527,127**.

In terms of **County** distribution; All **4** are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(4)**, 40-49 **(3)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today, **14** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care while. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,685** of whom **264,670** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,015** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** death has been reported and therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,648**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,309)**.

A total of **12** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **109** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). **2** patients are on supplemental oxygen and **all** of them are in the general wards. No patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
