PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of April 7th 2022, a total of **17,738,328** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,220,861** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,231,767** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **285,700** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **13,553** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **10,224**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **15** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,683** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.4%**. From the cases, **12** are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners. **8** are males while **7** are females. The youngest is a **12-year-old child** while the oldest is **90** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,521** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,543,928**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **7**, Kitui **3**, Nakuru **2**, Kiambu, Kilifi and Mombasa **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(2)**, 30-39 **(6)**, 40-49 **(2)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **12** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home-Based Isolation and Care while. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,747** of whom **264,732** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,015** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** death has been reported and therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,648**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**409**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,309**).

A total of **14** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **112** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care

Unit (ICU) or on supplemental oxygen or in the general wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
