PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of April 15th 2022, a total of **17,810,207** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,289,410** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,229,600** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **291,197** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **1,231** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **1,061**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **4** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,121** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.2%**. From the cases, **3** are foreigners while **1** is a Kenyan, and all the **4** are males. The youngest is a **29-year-old** while the oldest is **63** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,609** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,565,081**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **3** and Kwale **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(0)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **5** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care program. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,811** of whom **264,793** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,018** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

A total of **11** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **122** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) or on supplemental oxygen or in the general wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
