**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of April 20<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **17,837,914** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,313,182** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,231,273** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **293,459** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **8,425** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **5,498**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **18** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,086** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.9%**. From the cases, **13** are Kenyans and **5** are foreigners. **10** are males while **8** are females. The youngest is a **9-year-old child** while the oldest is **63** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,664** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,576,023**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **16**, Garissa and Trans Nzoia **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(6)**, 50-59 **(5)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **no** patient has recovered from the disease. The total recoveries remain **317,882** of whom **264,856** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,026** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

A total of **3** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **130** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) or on supplemental oxygen or in the general wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
