PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of April 24th 2022, a total of **17,871,145** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,340,560** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,233,817** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years while **296,768** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **3,198** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **2,215**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **9** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,236** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.4%**. From the cases **5** are foreigners and **4** are Kenyans. **7** males while **2** are females. The youngest is a **14-year-old** while the oldest is **56** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,718** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,586,406**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **8** and Uasin Gishu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(2)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **10** patients have recovered from the disease, **9** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program and **1** from a health facility in the country. This pushes the total recoveries to **317,919** of whom **264,892** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,027** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

A total of **2** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **137** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **1** patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
