PRESS STATEMENT

Today **36** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,967** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.2%**. From the cases **19** are foreigners while **17** are Kenyans. **21** males and **15** females. The youngest is a **5-**

year-old child while the oldest is **72** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,011** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,630,986**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **24**, Kiambu **8**, Lamu **2**, Kisumu and Narok **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(3)**, 10-19 years **(5)**, 20-29 years **(4)**, 30-39 **(9)**, 40-49 **(5)**, 50-59 **(6)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today, **10** patients have recovered from the disease, and all of them are from the Home Based and Isolation Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,130** of whom **265,102** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,028** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

A total of **6** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **226** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **2** patients are on supplemental oxygen and are in the general ward. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
