**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

**PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **4** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,220** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.3%**. From the cases all the **4** are Kenyans. **3** males while **1** is a female. The youngest is a **30-year-old** while

the oldest is **72** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,796** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,603,531**.

In terms of **County** distribution; All the **4** are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(1)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **8** patients have recovered from the disease, and all of them are from the Home Based and Isolation Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,010** of whom **264,982** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,028** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

A total of **4** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **122** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **1** patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
