PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of May 5th 2022, a total of **17,927,457** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,305,642** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,285,578** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **31,957** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **304,280** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **7,444** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **1,542**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **28** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,315** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.2%**. From the cases **18** are Kenyans while **10** are foreigners. **20** males and **8** females. The youngest is a **15-year-old** while the oldest is **66** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **323,846** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,610,647**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **18**, Kiambu **7**, Siaya **2** and Trans Nzoia **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(8)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(7)**, 40-49 **(6)**, 50-59 **(3)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today, **13** patients have recovered from the disease, and all of them are from the Home Based and Isolation Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,055** of whom **265,027** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,028** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

A total of **4** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **138** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **1** patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
