PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of May 14th 2022, a total of **18,005,808** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,353,974** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,306,931** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **32,430** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **312,473** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **2,221** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **977**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.7%**.

The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **15** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,285** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.7%**. From the cases **9** are Kenyans while **6** are foreigners. **8** males and **7** females. The youngest is a **9-year-old child** while the oldest is **72** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,026** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,633,271**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **14** and Kisumu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(1)**, 50-59 **(5)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **12** patients have recovered from the disease, and all of them are from the Home Based and Isolation Care. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,142** of whom **265,114** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,028** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

A total of **4** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **231** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **2** patients are on supplemental oxygen and are in the general ward. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
