PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of May 16th 2022, a total of **18,044,932** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,373,773** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,321,333** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **32,809** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **317,017** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **11,644** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **4,798**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated.

Today **32** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,059** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.6%**. From the cases **18** are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **18** males and **14** females. The youngest is a **3-year-old** while the oldest is **69** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,129** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,642,521**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **28**, Kiambu, Kisumu, Kwale and Makueni **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(3)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(4)**, 30-39 **(15)**, 40-49 **(7)**, 50-59 **(7)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **19** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,224** of whom **265,193** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,649**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(409)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,310)**.

There is **one** patient currently admitted in one of our health facilities, while **255** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
