## **PRESS STATEMENT**

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of May 22<sup>nd</sup> 2022, a total of **18,096,698** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,398,696** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,341,402** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **33,452** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **323,148** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **6,193** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **2,105**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **32** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,446** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.2%**. From the cases **26** are Kenyans while **6** are foreigners. **20** males and **12** females. The youngest is a **9-year-old** while the oldest is **70** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,274** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,650,765**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **23**, Kisumu **5**, Nakuru, Kajiado, Kiambu and Meru **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (1), 10-19 years (3), 20-29 years (7), 30-39 (7), 40-49 (7), 50-59 (3), 60 years and above (4).

Today, **48** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,324** of whom **265,293** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(410)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,311)**.

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **296** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
